Outcomes

We're powering through 2026 — more clients are on the verge of becoming debt free, and with appointments fully booked through September, demand shows no sign of slowing down. Our grand total is now at £1.3m since 2018. Two clients have both cleared £26k this month!

CAP United Conference

Martin Pointing and a group of 8 Befrienders, Job Club Managers and Life Skills Manager attended the 30th anniversary CAP United conference at Westminster Chapel in June.

It was an encouraging and inspiring day as delegates heard John Kirkby, the CAP founder, speak on Matthew 9 on a plentiful harvest with few workers. CEO Stuart McCulloch then explained that CAP had supported clients to pay back or write off half a billion pounds of debt. God is on the march and we are his hands and feet! He reiterated the message in Isaiah 61 about being "good news to the poor."

The day even featured a personal message of congratulations from Martin Lewis, Money Saving Expert to CAP members on our 30th anniversary.
